Motion 1003-RW1 (Travel//Passed)

The Pacific Swimming Board of Directors shall approve Travel Assistance in the Imounts:

Pacific Swimming Board of Directors Meeting March 24, 2010

Senior Committee motion to change designation of Junior and Senior meet qualifying times and clarify language surrounding entry in Junior meets.

Currently, the Jr./Jr. T&F/Snr/Snr T&F qualifying times have little to do with the meet format. These times are largely used to manage meet size. This motion proposes that we refer to this entire classification of meets as "Senior meets" and re-name the standards to reflect their actual usage:

Senior I Formerly Senior T&F
Senior II Formerly Senior
Senior III Formerly Junior T&F
Formerly Junior

Changes to sections 1.B.1.a; 2.B; 3.A.8.b; 5.A.1; 5.A.3 and 9.C.1.c reflect these changes.

The language surrounding the ability for a 13 and over swimmer to enter a (formerly) Junior or Junior T&F meet without qualifying times is unclear and in places redundant. Changes to section 5.B.1.a; 5.B.1.b; 5.B.1.c reflect this.

New additions are italicized and underlined. Language that is removed is stricker. Changes are as follows:

SECTION 1 ADMINISTRATION OF THE SWIMMING PROGRAM

B. Classes and Time Standards

1. Classes of Swimming Competition

- a. Swimming competition shall be conduced by various classes. The classes of swimmers are:
- (1) Senior
- (2) Junior
- (3) Age Group 18 years of age and younger, grouped by ages
- (4) Post Age Group 19/over (5) Novice

B. Entry Fees

1. The following are entry fees which shall be charged for each class of meet. The meet sponsor is not required to accept entries that do not include applicable fees. Participation fees cannot be charged unless entry fees are charged.

SECTION 5 SENIOR COMPETITION

A. Qualifying

- 1. A swimmer will qualify for Senior <u>I</u>(1), <u>II</u>(2) or Junior competition when he or she has equaled or bettered the published time standard for the event. <u>Thirteen</u> and over swimmers may qualify for Senior level <u>III</u>(3) and Senior level <u>IV</u>(4) meets without qualifying times. These events should be entered at the entry time. Twelve and under swimmers must meet Senior level <u>III</u>(3) and <u>Senior level IV</u>(4) times to qualify for level <u>III</u>(3) and <u>IV</u>(4) meets.
- A swimmer may qualify in any sanctioned or approved competition, or in an observed swim.
- 3. A swimmer who qualifies Senior or Junior in a specific stroke and distance will be considered qualified in the same stroke and distance in all courses. For all Senior and Junior meets enter your time for the course that you qualified.

Level 2 - Primary system: Semi-automatic with 3 buttons Age group meets with qualifying times of A or higher (including multi-class meets) and Junior and/or Senior meets must have at least a Level 2 primary timing system with a minimum backup system of at least one watch; <u>timing system guidelines will be outlined in the minimum criteria Senior meet document established by the Senior committee.</u>

9.C.1.c

The coach/team must attend at least three (3) of the designated Pacific Swimming Junior and Senior level meets during the previous twelve (12) month period. There shall be a limit of two (2) national level meets for which a coach/team may receive travel assistance per year. The Senior Committee will determine eligibility.

SENIOR COMPETITION

A. Qualifying

- A swimmer will qualify for Senior or Junior competition when he or she has equaled or bettered the published time standard for the event.
- A swimmer may qualify in any sanctioned or approved competition, or in an observed swim.
- A swimmer who qualifies <u>for</u> Senior or <u>Junior</u> competition in a specific stoke and distance will be considered qualified in the same stroke and distance in all courses. For all Senior and <u>Junior</u> meets enter your time for the course that you qualified.

B Eligibility

1. Senior Meets

- a. In all meets with trials and finals, swimmers are eligible to enter all events in which they have equaled or bettered the listed time standards, but may not swim more than three (3) individual events per day.
- b. In all timed finals meets, swimmers are eligible to enter all events in which they have equaled or bettered the listed time standard, but may not swim more than five (5) individual events per day.
- c. In all Senior meets, a swimmer that is able to prove their time in one or more events may enter two (2) additional (bonus) events along with the provable event(s). Performance penalties will not apply to the bonus event(s). The swimmer must enter their actual time for the bonus event(s) and circle the time on the entry form to indicate that it is a bonus event.

- e. A swimmer who qualifies **for a** Senior **meet** or Junior in a specific stroke and distance will be considered qualified in the same stroke and distance in all courses. If the time was made SCY and it is a SCM or an LCM meet, enter your SCY time. If the time was made SCM and it is a SCY or an LCM meet, enter your SCM time. If the time was made LCM and it is a SCY or an SCM meet, enter your LCM time. When entering a meet, if your qualifying time is in yards enter the yards time and put a Y after the time. If the qualifying time is in Short Course meters enter that time with an S after it. If the qualifying time is in long course meters then enter that time with an L after it.
- f. No time conversions will be accepted.

2. Junior Meets

- a. 1. Swimmers, thirteen years and older will be considered entered in Senior level III (3), IV (4) meets without proof of time. These events should be entered at the entry time. are eligible to enter all events in Junior meets in which they have equaled or bettered the listed Junior time standards. They may not swim in more than five (5) events per day. Swimmers 13 years of age or over will be considered qualified for these meets without proof of time. Swimmers 12 years of age and under must meet the time standard (bonus events excepted) and will be subject to proof of time per B.1.d. above.
- b. A Junior swimmer shall maintain that classification for the duration of a meet.

 Even if a swimmer qualifies for Senior competition in a stroke and distance, he or

 she may still enter a Junior relay event in that stroke and distance in the same meet.
- c. Once swimmers attain the Senior Time standard in a particular event in a Junior meet, or any other meet, they may not enter the same event in another Junior meet unless the meet is designated Junior +.

C. Conduct of Meets

- Senior and Junior meets shall offer all events that are swum in the National Championship meets. Relay events are optional.
- 2. <u>Senior meet formats (2/2.5/3 day events, prelims/finals or timed finals) will be outlined in the minimum criteria Senior meet document estabished by the Senior Committee.</u> Senior meets, short course or long course, which are of three days duration shall be operated on the trials and finals system with corsolation finals, and the championship shall precede the consolation heat. Two-day Serior meets may be operated on the trials and finals system. Qualifying meets and Junior meats may be operated on the trials and finals system.
- 3. In two-day timed finals Senior meets and Senior qualifying meets there are no pre-entry requirements. Entries will be made and heats established on the deck at the meet. Swimmers must bring filled out entry cards to the meet.
- 4. Two-day Senior and Junior meets shall be flexible and conducted in accordance with recommendation of the Senior Committee.

D. Awards

- 1. <u>Award criteria for all Senior level meets will be outlined in the minimum criteria Senior meet document.</u> In Senior meets having heats and finals, awards for finalists are optional.
- 2. Award criteria will be outlined in No awards shall be given in two-day timed finals Senior meets or in Senior-qualifying meets.
- 3. In Junior meets awards are optional; holever, if offered, thire shall be a minimum of six individual awards for each event and team awards are recommended.
