### **Officer's Reports**:

Chair-

- It is not too soon to think about and plan for the USA-S Convention in September. Carole Yoshiwara will attend again this year; however, Pacific will need an athlete rep to replace Kyla Power. Pacific is eligible for 3 At Large representatives. The hospitality suite for Pacific has been reserved.
- An ad for the Administrative Assistant will be in the San Jose Mercury News on Sunday, 5/28 or 6/4, in the Career Builder section (which has nationwide coverage); the opening will also be listed on the PC website.
- It is expected that Reno will submit an application next month to the House of Delegates, asking to transfer to the Sierra Nevada LSC. To date, no other clubs in Zone 4 are considering such a change.

### Treasurer-

• Net Worth, as adjusted for the USA-S Liability and the commitment to the Salinas Community Pool, is \$1,239,639.

### Age Group -

- The Committee is still accepting applications for coaches and managers for the Western Zone meet. The Head Coach (selected last year) may withdraw due to a conflict as some of his swimmers may qualify for nationals.
- Having difficulty getting technical support from Hy-tek for Team Manager.

- Learning about IMX (virtual) competition.
- Darwin presented the parent symposium at the 10/U Camp, with very positive feedback. Made a shorter presentation at the Zone 1S bi-monthly meeting and have inquiries from two clubs.

**Registration** – Regular athlete registration is 11,886 (down 8% from last year), and summer season registration is 455 (up 25% from last year). Total athlete registration is 12,341 (down 1% from last year.

#### Senior –

- The 2007 Spring Sectional meet has been moved to Long Beach (Belmont Plaza) and will be hosted by Mission Viejo.
- The Senior Committee will work with Local Legislation to draft changes to Section 5 of the Rules & Regulations to accomplish the senior proposal as approved last month. These changes will be presented at the September BOD meeting.

- Added a dual meet in June, and a one-day meet in August.

Zone 3 (Warren Lager) – met 5/15; next meeting 6/19 at Rohnert Park Comm. Center, 7:30p.

- Changed the Dec 2-3 meet from a C/B Zone 3 qualifier to a C/B/BB+ meet and re-opened the bidding.
