USE OF AUDIO AND VISUAL: Photography and video recording from behind the blocks or starting areas is prohibited unless prior permission is granted by the Meet Referee. Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, and Google Glass is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

LOCATION: De Anza College: 21250 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino, CA 95014.

DIRECTIONS: From the North: Take Highway 280 South. Exit right on De Anza Blvd. Turn right on Stevens Creek Blvd. Turn Left on Stelling St. Enter the College Campus on the right hand side from Stelling St. and use Parking Lot C for easiest access to the pool. From the South: Take Highway 280 North. Exit left on De Anza Blvd. Turn Right on Stevens Creek Blvd. Turn left on Stelling St. Enter the College Campus on the right hand side from Stelling St. and use Parking Lot C for easiest access to the poll. PLEASE NOTE THERE WILL BE MANDATORY PARKING FEES OF \$3.00 (CASH OR CREDIT) EACH DAY. Parking fees will be reimbursed for working officials.

COURSE: 50 meter, outdoor heated pool. Up to ten (10) lanes will be used for competition. Chase starts may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Separate, warm-up, cool down area will be available during the meet. The minimum water depth for the shallow end course, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 5'0" at the start end and 5'0" at the turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

TIME: FRIDAY SESSION: Meet begins at 5:00 PM; Warm-up is from 3:45 – 4:45 PM.

SATURDAY/SUNDAY SESSION A (13 & Over and 11 – 12 GIRLS: Meet begins at 8:30 AM; Warm-Up is from 7:00 – 8:15 AM. SATURDAY/SUNDAY SESSION B (10 & Under and 11 – 12 BOYS): Session B will begin 1 hour after Session A finishes, but not before 12:00 PM. Session B Warm-Ups will begin immediately after Session A finishes.

RULES:

- Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.
- All events are timed finals.
- All events will swim fast to slow.
- Athletes may compete in a maximum of **one (1)** event on Friday and **three (3)** events per day on Saturday and Sunday.
- All athletes ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours.
- Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated time line, per the "Four-Hour Rule," based on the athletes age and gender.
- If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.
- All athletes competing in the 1500 meter Freestyle, 400 meter Freestyle or 400 meter IM must have achieved a USA-S "B" Time Standard for their age group and gender.

- All athletes competing in the 1500 meter Freestyle, 400 meter Freestyle or 400 meter IM events must provide their own lane timers. Athletes competing in the 1500 meter Freestyle must provide their own lap counters.
- The 1500 meter Freestyle will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girl's and boy's heats. Girl's and boy's heats may be combined at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
- The 1500 meter Freestyle may be swum 2 per lane pending the timeline and Meet Referee discretion.
- All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner.

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETES: Any USA-S athlete-member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming member-coach for the purposes of athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a coach-member of the athlete's USA-S Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the athlete or the athlete's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA-S member-coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the athlete's USA-S Club Member-Coach.

RACING STARTS: Athletes must be certified by a USA-S member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start, or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the athlete or the athlete's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by athletes, during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue.
- No propane heater is permitted except for snack bar/meet operations.
- All shelters must be properly secured.
- Pets, with the exception of working service animals, are prohibited in the meet venue.
- Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

• Destructive devices, to include but not limited to, explosive devices and equipment, firearms (open or concealed), blades, knives, mace, stun guns and blunt objects are strictly prohibited in the swimming facility and its surrounding areas. If observed, the Meet Referee or his/her designee may ask that these devices be stored safely away from the public or removed from the facility. Noncompliance may result in the reporting to law enforcement authorities and ejection from the facility. Law enforcement officers (LEO) are exempt per applicable laws.

• Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

ELIGIBILITY:

• Athletes must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the athlete with the registration and times database. The meet host will check all athlete registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail.

• Athletes in the "A" Division must have met at least USA Swimming Motivational "A" minimum time standard. Athletes in the "B" Division must have met at least the listed "B" minimum time standard. All entry times slower than the listed "B" time standard will be in the "C" Division.

• Entries with "NO TIME" will be ACCEPTED. (Exception – 1500 Free, 400 Free, and 400 IM. See rules).

• Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.

- Disabled athletes are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.
- Athletes 19 years of age and over may compete in the meet for time only, no awards. Such athletes must have met standards for the 17-18 age group.
- The athlete's age will be the age of the athlete on the first day of the meet.

ENTRY PRIORITY: Athletes from DACA, HDAC, LAMV, MNLO, OSC, PCCA, PPSC, PSRP, SUNN, SOLO entering online must do so by 11:59 PM Wednesday, May 24th in order to receive priority acceptance to the meet. Surface mail entries must be postmarked by Monday, May 22nd in order to receive priority acceptance to the meet. <u>No athletes other than those from DACA, HDAC, LAMV, MNLO, OSC, PCCA, PPSC, PSRP, SUNN, SOLO may enter the meet until the priority period has concluded.</u>

ENTRY FEES: \$4.00 per event plus a \$10.00 participation fee per athlete. Entries will be rejected if payment is not sent at time of request. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs.

ONLINE ENTRIES: To enter online go to <u>http://ome.swimconnection.com/pc/DACA20170609</u> to receive an immediate entry confirmation. This method requires payment by credit card. Swim Connection, LLC charges a processing fee for this service, equal to \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total Entry Fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of an athlete by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted through Wednesday, May 31st, 2017 at 11:59 PM.

MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES: Entries must be on the attached consolidated entry form. Forms must be filled out completely and printed clearly with the athlete's best time. Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday, May 29th, 2017 or hand delivered by 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 31st, 2017. No late entries will be accepted. Requests for confirmation of receipt of entries should include a self-addressed envelope.

CHECK-IN: The meet will be deck seeded. Athletes must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. No event shall be closed more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session. Close of check-in for all individual events shall be no more than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. Athletes who do not check in will not be seeded and will not be allowed to compete in that event.

SCRATCHES: Any athlete not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event that they have checked in for shall not be penalized.

AWARDS: Individual events will be awarded in the A, B, and C division. Ribbons for First through Eighth place will be given to the following age groups 8 & U, 9-10, 11-12. Athletes 13 years of age and older will not receive awards. "A" time medals will be given to swimmers achieving a new "A" time (PC-A for 8 & Under Athletes, USA-S A for 9 & Over Athletes), regardless of place achieved in the event. All awards must be picked up at the meet by coaches at the end of the meet. Awards will not be mailed.

ADMISSION: Free. A 3-day program will NOT be available for purchase. The program will be posted at <u>http://www.daca.org</u> and e-mailed to coaches of participating clubs prior to the meet.

SNACK BAR & HOSPITALITY: A snack bar will be open each day. Generous and friendly hospitality provided for officials, and coaches.

MISCELLANEOUS: No overnight parking is allowed. Facilities will not be provided after meet hours. All participating clubs are expected to provide lane timers based upon the number of athletes registered to swim each day. Club timing lanes for Saturday and Sunday will be assigned and coaches will be notified of assignments during the week prior to the meet.

MINIMUM OFFICIALS: Clubs must follow Zone 1 North rules for providing officials. Each club must provide officials for each session according to the number of athletes entered in that session, following the table below. Clubs that do not provide sufficient officials must provide coaches to act in the place of officials.
