

## Pacific Swimming 2008 Zones' All-Star Developmental Meet Sunday, March 2, 2008

Sanction: Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. 0348

<u>Course</u>: 50 meter X 25 yard indoor heated pool. 8 short course lanes for competition and 8 short course lanes for warm-up and warm-down. Colorado Timing System with Touch Pads and scoreboard.

<u>Location</u>: Carson Aquatic Facility, 841 N. Roop St. Carson City, NV. From Business Hwy. 395 go two traffic lights East on Hwy. 50 (E. Williams St.). Turn right on Roop St. and go one block south. Turn left behind the Carson City Community Center. From Reno on Hwy. 395 take exit 39. Turn right and travel West for .9 mile. Turn left into Mills Park and the Carson City Community Center. Additional parking is available at the Bank of America at the north-west corner of Roop St. and Hwy. 50 (E. Williams St.).

Time: Competition begins at 10:00am. Pool will be available for warm-up from 8:45am to 9:45am.

Rules: Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA-S membership card in a visible manner. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. All events shall be timed finals and shall be limited to two heats per event. Swimmers may compete in as many 3 individual events plus 2 relays. Each Zone team may have up to 3 swimmers in each individual event and up to 2 teams in each relay event. All events shall be pre-seeded. Each Zone team will be assigned three lanes for the meet by performance of last years meet. Assignments will be as follows:

Swimmers will be seeded into their team's assigned lanes. Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest. The meet referee, with the concurrence of the meet director, may impose a mandatory scratchdown.

<u>Restrictions</u>: Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating or standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and warm-up periods. Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.

Eligibility: This meet is open only to swimmers who have been selected to compete via a process decided by each Zone. Swimmers who have competed at Western Zone All Stars or the Pacific Coast Meet are not eligible. An alternate swimmer who replaces an entered swimmer must compete in the entered swimmer's events. Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee).

Check In: Submission of an entry sheet constitutes check-in.

Scratches: There shall be no penalty for failing to swim a scheduled event.

**Entries:** Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.

Entries must be submitted by 8:00 p.m. Monday, February 25. Entries must be emailed using Hy-Tek data format by February 25, 2008. If you would like you swimmers seeded in a particular order in your assigned lanes you must summit your entries from Hy-Tek Meet Manger 2.0 file already seeded with your with "Entries for Meet Manager Merge of the same meet". Swimmers will not be reseeded at the meet.

Awards: There shall be no individual awards. A trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring Zone team.
