### **Zone 2 Report    Clint Benton -- February 22, 2010**

Meeting was held on February 8, 2010 in San Leandro, California. During the meeting discussions were held on how to deal with recruiting Officials for the Zone and last minute issues regarding the Zone 2 Championships.

Zone 2 Championship was held on February 20-21, 2010 at San Ramon California High. There were over 900 swimmers and it was held on two courses and ended around 2:30 PM on each day.

The Zone had all officials attend the meet and formed teams to allow for the Zone Senior officials to train officials in all deck positions. The team training approach seemed to work very well with all involved pleased with the results.

During the meet the Zone All Star team was also selected.

### **Zone 3 – Lee Rosichan – February 8, 2010**

1) We discussed our Zone Championship meet, and the problems that were encountered. Cameron Tyson was lauded for his excellent job as Meet Director, especially due to the circumstances that developed. We also formed a committee to look into the possibility of moving the meet to another date, since we no longer have the opportunity to use the USF Koret pool.

2) We bought 8 touchpads, 4 used and 4 new, which will be stored at SRJC. They were used at the Zone meet and worked quite well.

3) We discussed the Zone All-Star meet and preparations that were being concluded.

4) Five new meets have been added to the zone schedule for this spring and summer. The Piranhas will host four one-day invitational meets at the Honeybee Pool in Rohnert Park aimed primarily at novice swimmers. The dates of the meets are Saturday, April 17; Sunday, May 16; Saturday, June 5; and Sunday, July 18. In addition, the Mendocino Coast Sea Dragons will host an invitational meet the weekend of May 8-9 at the new C. V. Starr Center indoor pool in Fort Bragg.

5) Greg Hawkes asked us to look for replacements for Treasurer and Sanctions Chair by the end of the calendar year.

6) We also voted to include Fort Bragg in our exempted status with the North Coast teams, and that will have to go before the Pacific Board for approval.
