

SANCTION: Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. 25-064

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

LOCATION: Saratoga High School – 20300 Herriman Ave., Saratoga, CA 95070

COURSE: Outdoor 50 meter x 25 yard pool with up to 7 lanes available for competition. One long course lane will be available for warm-up/cool down throughout the competition. The minimum water depth for the shallow end course, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 10'0" at the start end and 4'0" at the turn end. The Meet Host shall ensure required course dimensions.

TIME: Friday: The meet will begin at 5:00 PM with warm-ups from 4:00 – 4:50 PM. Saturday/Sunday: The meet will begin at 8:30 AM with warm-ups from 7:00 – 8:20 AM.

RULES: • Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.

• The local facilities guidelines, restrictions and interpretation of the local public health guidelines shall be followed at this meet.

• All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA

Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

- All events are timed finals.
- All events will swim fast to slow.
- Athletes may compete in two (2) events on Friday and three (3) events per day on Saturday/Sunday.
- All Athletes ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours.

• Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated timeline, per the "Four-Hour Rule," based on the Athletes age and gender.

• If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.

• Athletes entered in the 400 IM, 400 Free and/or 800 Free must provide their own timers. Athletes entered in the 800 Free must provide their own lap counters.

• Athletes entered in the 400 IM, 400 Free, and/or 800 Free must have achieved a minimum USA-S Motivational "B" time for their age group/gender. Coach verified times shall be accepted.

- The mixed 800 Freestyle shall be limited to 4 total heats (28 athletes).
- No Time Entries shall NOT be accepted for events 200m and longer. Coach verified and/or converted times shall be accepted.
- The Friday PM Session shall be capped at a timeline of 2.5 Hours.
- First Aid and an AED are available to participants and attendees. Lifeguards will NOT be on duty.
- All Coaches and Officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner. USA-Swimming's Application is valid as proof of current membership.

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETES: Any USA Swimming Athlete-Member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming Member-Coach for the purposes of Athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a Coach-Member of the Athlete's USA Swimming Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming Member-Coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the Athlete in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the Athlete's USA Swimming Club Member-Coach.

RACING STARTS: Athletes must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RESTRICTIONS: • Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator

- seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by Athletes, during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue.
- No propane heater is permitted except for snack bar/meet operations.
- All shelters must be properly secured.
- Deck Changes are prohibited.

• Destructive devices, to include but not limited to, explosive devices and equipment, firearms (open or concealed), blades, knives, mace, stun guns and blunt objects are strictly prohibited in the swimming facility and its surrounding areas. If observed, the Meet Referee or his/her designee may ask that these devices be stored safely away from the public or removed from the facility. Noncompliance may result in the reporting to law enforcement authorities and ejection from the facility. Law enforcement officers (LEO) are exempt per applicable laws.

• Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, Athlete/Coach areas, Spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time Athletes, Coaches, Officials and/or Spectators are present.

ELIGIBILITY: • Athletes must be current members of USA Swimming and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the Athlete with the registration and times database. The meet host will check all Athlete registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, Athletes shall be required to register online via USA Swimming's online member registration before being allowed to swim in the meet.

• Entries with "NO TIME" will be accepted. (EXCEPTION – events 200m and longer. See Rules).

• Entry times submitted for this meet may be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.

• Athletes with a disability are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.

• Athletes 19 years of age and over may compete in the meet for time only, no awards. Such Athletes must have met standards for the 17-18 age group.

• The Athlete's age will be the age of the Athlete on the first day of the meet.

ENTRY FEES: \$4.50 per event plus a \$14.00 participation fee per Athlete. Entries will be rejected if payment is not sent at time of request. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs.

ENTRY PRIORITY: Zone 1N Athletes entering online must do so by 11:59 PM, Saturday, May 3rd in order to receive priority acceptance to the meet. Zone 1N Athlete's surface mail entries must be postmarked by Thursday, May 1st in order to receive priority acceptance to the meet. <u>No athletes other than those in Zone 1N may enter the meet until the preference period has concluded.</u>

ONLINE ENTRIES: To enter online go to <u>http://ome.fastswims.com</u> to receive an immediate entry confirmation. This method requires payment by credit card. FastSwims charges a service fee for this service, 6.5% of the total Entry Fees plus \$0.75 per transaction, regardless of number of Athletes. Please note that the service fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the service fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of an Athlete by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted through **Wednesday, May 7th, 2025** (pending the meet does not fill up sooner per the "Four-Hour Rule, see Rules above).

MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES: Entries must be on the attached consolidated entry form. Forms must be filled out completely and printed clearly with Athlete's best time. Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday May 5th or hand delivered by 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 7th. No late entries will be accepted. Requests for confirmation of receipt of entries should include a self-addressed envelope.

CHECK-IN: The meet will be deck seeded. Athletes must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. No event shall be closed more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session. On Friday, close of check-in for each event shall be no more than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. SCRATCHES: Any Athletes not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event that they have checked in for shall not be penalized.

AWARDS: None.

ADMISSION: Free. A digital 3-day psych sheet will be distributed prior to competition.

SNACK BAR & HOSPITALITY: No snack bar. Coaches and working Officials will be provided dinner Friday and breakfast/light lunch on Saturday & Sunday. Hospitality will serve refreshments to timers and volunteers.

MISCELLANEOUS: No overnight parking is allowed. Facilities will not be provided after meet hours.

MINIMUM OFFICIALS: Clubs must follow Zone 1 North rules for providing officials. Each club must provide officials for each session according to the number of athletes entered in that session, following the table below.
